I wrote to you earlier this week, regarding certain publications of the Cyprus Mail, from 2002 which you have in your archive. I refer to Cyprus Mail reports published on August 20, 21 and 24 2002, regarding a Mr Christodoulos Yiallourous who was at the time director of the Nicosia Sewage Board. Our paper has been contacted by Mr Yiallourous' lawyers who inform us that their client was acquitted of all charges in 2005. Yet a google search of his name still brings up the above-mentioned articles on your web-site.

I do not know what libel laws are in the US, but I have no desire to be dragged into legal adventures, for something published on your web-site without the authorisation of the Cyprus Mail. Could you please tell me what you propose to do about this matter.

1. I represented Mr. Yiallourous in the case 18956/02 of the District Court of Nicosia. In the said case Mr. Yiallourous was accused of committing offences in relation to his qualifications.
2. On 6/9/2005 the Court acquitted Mr. Yiallourous of all charges he was facing. The Court noted, in particular, that there was not a shred of evidence on which to base the charge of forgery and that the accusation that Mr. Yiallourous had obtained his employment under false pretences had not been substantiated.

EX – GENERAL MANAGER OF THE SEWERAGE BOARD OF NICOSIA
HAS BEEN ACQUITTED NOT GUILTY

The District Court of Nicosia gave its judgment to the sensational trial of Christodoulos Yiallouros ex- General Manager of the Sewerage Board of Nicosia.

Mr. Yiallouros was charged that he forged and circulated a certificate presenting him as chartered certified accountant of the United Kingdom. Also, presenting himself as chartered certified accountant obtained employment at the Sewerage Board of Nicosia and subsequently he was promoted to the post of the General Manager. The Republic, in prosecuting Mr. Yiallouros, sought the return of his total earnings in the Sewerage Board of Nicosia amounting to £570,000. Finally, the accused was charged with the accusation that he refused to conform in a written order of the police examiners to present his certificate under discussion.

The District Judge Mr. Yiapanas found Mr. Yiallouros not guilty and acquitted him from all the charges. The Judge noted that there was not a shred of evidence on which to base legally the offence of forgery. Also, the Court ruled that the allegation that Yiallouros's employment had been obtained under false pretences had not been substantiated. Furthermore, the Judge deemed that, according to the law, the onus of presenting documents could not lie with the accused since this would run contrary to the right of no self – discrimination.

The accused was represented by the Lawyers Menelaos Kyprianou of the Law Office of Michalakis Kyprianou & Co and Christakis Christaki of the Law Office of A.S. Angelides & Co.

Ex-director acquitted

THE FORMER Director General of the Nicosia Sewerage Board (NSB) Christodoulos Yiallourous has been acquitted by the Nicosia District Court of forging a chartered accountant's qualification in order to obtain employment.

The Judge said there was not a shred of evidence on which to base legally the offence of forgery.

He also ruled that the allegation that Yiallourous's employment had been obtained under false pretences had not been substantiated. Furthermore, the judge noted that, according to the law, the onus of presenting documents could not lie with the accused since this would run contrary to the right of non self-discrimination.

In prosecuting Yiallourous, the Republic sought the return of his total earnings in the NSB, amounting to £570,000.
